## How to make a flat circle with trebles

## Notes

Start with a magic loop. Begin each round with 2 ch . Join the end of the round with a slip stitch into the first tr of the round - ignore the chains as if they aren't there, this avoids any holes showing in your work along the seam line.

Round 1-12 tr into the loop-12
Round 2-2 tr into each tr-24
Round 3-2 tr into first tr, 1 tr into next tr, repeat to end - 36
Round 4-2 tr into first tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr repeat to end - 48
Round 5-2 tr into first tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr - 60
Round 6-2 tr into first tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr - 72
Round 7-2 tr into first tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr, 1 tr into next tr - 84

Carry on with this formula, adding 12 stitches every round until it reaches the required size.

Here is the formula at a glance
12 tr
$2 \operatorname{tr} \times 12=24$
$2 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr} \times 12=36$
$2 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr} \times 12=48$
$2 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr} 1 \mathrm{tr}, \times 12=60$
$2 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr} \times 12=72$
$2 \operatorname{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr} \times 12=84$
